

PITCH -- The Final Solution

Going to their patriarch's promotion party at Nazi Headquarters, Posen, Polen, taking the wrong train, a mother and her two young sons become uninvited guests at Death Camp Treblinka. A Grimm fairytale. When they can't prove they're "Arians" and thereby not part of the Technicians' problem, they become part of the -- for SS eyes only -- "Final Solution."

A tale that becomes even grimmer when Herr Obersturmbannführer enters Hell to save his family is immediately *stripped* of his *stripes* by the camp's commandant- degraded to Untermensch - and send to Hells Factory.

Treblinka's story of an Arian family that's not actively killed as the other inmates are, but not saved either. Himmler and the camp commandant agree on one thing: Let nature do its job. Limbo land.

Knowing the *pit's towering inferno* will die soon, he must find out if his family is still alive and works in the Ghetto, German or Ukrainian quarters..

If so, keep them alive until Treblinka's D-Day. By diving deep into Grimm's *rabbit hole*, confess his secret, *prove* his *loyalty*, and thereby gain his *inmates* trust – he becomes an important member of the Committee and can now plan and *lead* the upcoming *uprising*.
