LOGLINE

Latino Rockabilly Davy and his wacky band pals launch a ghost hunting reality show, 805 Paranormal, in their dingy barrio. They don't know it yet, but after a deal with the devil they trigger a series of events that will bring Armageddon.

SYNOPSIS

The 805 isn't your typical barrio.

It's the epicenter of spiritual activity with a surprising number of ghosts and demons haunting the neighborhood.

Of the many diverse characters in the 805, Davy is special among them. He's never known what to do with his supernatural abilities until one of his band mates masterminds a reality TV show called "805 Paranormal."


However, success comes with a price to pay. The very power that allows Davy to hunt ghosts and fight demons also triggers the Apocalypse in this half-hour, TV-MA show.

MAIN CHARACTER

Davy Gato (30s), is a Latino Rockabilly with Cry Baby hair who jingles down the street to the sound of his wallet chain and rattlesnake skin boots.

He agrees to join "805 Paranormal," a ghost hunting reality show set in their hometown barrio, with his rock band "ninja cupcakes."

What no one knows is that Davy has "The Sight Beyond Sight," a wide open third-eye that illuminates people's auras showing goodness or evil. Davy cannot only see ghosts, he can fight demons.

MAIN CHARACTER

Davy's hunchback grandma (80s), an immigrant who never quite fit in America.

These days, she's seen with a cane, a black veil, and a hand sewn black shawl. She is a simple woman with a good heart.

A faithful woman who fears God and church, she's also a secret "bruja," or witch. Turns out, Davy's powers run in the family.

She wants to die quietly in her sleep so as not to be a burden on her grandson who already gave up education to take care of her.

CHEEZE

MAIN CHARACTER


He is the creator of "805 Paranormal," and its cameraman. He's also the drummer of ninja cupcakes.

Short, chubby, and white, with constant "Cheetos fingers," everyone thinks Cheeze (30s) is special.

He claims to be a lucky Irishman who's brown on the inside. He wears a Virgin Mary tee shirt, but isn't fooling anybody.

Davy's childhood best friend, he's never doubted his friend's supernatural powers.

MAIN CHARACTER

Tall and skinny, PACO “DJ PUNX” (20s) is the 3rd wheel youngster of the ninja cupcakes trio who slices it up on the scratchin' and cuttin,' and sometimes bass guitar.

Paco dresses like a punker with glasses, but boasts eclectic music tastes spanning the eras.

Still living at home with Mama, skinny Paco suffers from harsh intestinal issues dating back to his getting bullied days, hiding terrified in small places.

He's the tech guy for the TV show since he knows about electronics and ghost hunting gadgets.

ESMERALDA

MAIN CHARACTER

“La Demonia” Esmeralda, (30s) is a cut-throat business woman with a lust for power.

A Latina Betty Page with librarian glasses, she runs the legendary Magic Lantern Gentlemen’s Club and operates out of the 11th floor of the Mobius Paradise Estates with a harem of highly deadly stripper assassins.

She wants to run an empire of badass women, and needs to be in control.

Even though she lives in the 805 underworld, she thinks she’s the good one.

MAIN CHARACTER

Zell (50s), the mob boss of the 805, also known as “El Misterioso,” is the devil in the flesh. He can make either your dreams or nightmares come true.

Christopher Walken-looking, Zell is perpetually well dressed. Handsome, with a winning face and a pleasant voice. Zell moves easy, graceful, and confident, not slouchy, and awkward like most men.

He’s the only one who understands the full extent Davy’s supernatural powers, and has his own motives for bank rolling the ghost hunting show “805 Paranormal.”

MUMBLES

MAIN CHARACTER


The “eyes and ears” of the 805 barrio, Mumbles (70s) is a black homeless man, who reveres Davy and his grandma. Mumbles wears grimy, ratty clothes as a disguise. He understands Davy has special abilities like him.

After surviving a near death airplane crash in Vietnam, Mumbles developed one of the same powers as Davy, to see auras. However, when he told others they said he was crazy. He even got locked up.

Now pretending to be a stuttering hobo, he watches over the Gato family and often battles evil in the streets late at night.

FATHER ELIAS

MAIN CHARACTER

An African priest, Father Elias (50s) is a popular Catholic and community leader valiantly facing the rising tide of crime with nonviolence. He is a walking talking St. Martin, anointing the sick when needed.

He's a friend to animals, children, the sick, and the elderly. He'll soon be called on to perform his worst nightmare, exorcisms.

He wants to be a humble servant, and feels the need to help people.

PILOT

The 805 area code is a bustling, low income neighborhood with an iconic apartment building, San Gabriel Arcángel, at its center. However, it's also spook central. Ghosts, demons, and other ghouls make the 805 their home. No wonder everyone calls the neighborhood, "The dark side of the road." These supernatural beings can torment humans, and most of them are up to no good.

One person who can deal with the supernatural is Davy Gato. An everyday hero who takes care of his Abuelita, he affords to go to night school by pushing brooms all day. He loves passing time with his band ninja cupcakes.

Davy and ninja cupcakes are invited to a super upscale private party on the 11th floor of Mobius Paradise Estates, the opposite connecting luxury building to their barrio apartments, San Gabriel Arcángel.

Paco scores the party gig after working the DJ booth for Esmeralda, "La Demonia," at the Magic Lantern, the premiere gentlemen's club of the 805. This is their biggest break yet.

That night, Davy's "Sight Beyond Sight," triggers by seeing horns and a tail grow out of Esmeralda while performing her second dance, the death dance of Kali. He's overwhelmed by the glowing red auras of the unsavory crowd of underworld characters.

Soon, Davy meets the devil in the form of El Misterioso, the Mysterious Stranger who goes by the name Zell, an intriguing fallen archangel with high class sensibilities. He knows Davy has real supernatural abilities. So, Zell tempts Davy with an offer he can't refuse. He offers to produce Cheeze's "805 Paranormal" ghost hunting television show idea. Although, he keeps his motives to himself.

EPISODE CONCEPTS

EPISODE 1: "PILOT - WELCOME TO THE 805"

The 805 comes alive in a rundown neighborhood filled with fascinating characters. Chief among them is Davy, a Latino Rockabilly with supernatural gifts. Davy, and his band perform for the infamous El Misterioso, and the gig leads to financing for the *805 Paranormal* TV show, but it's a deal with the devil.

EPISODE 2: "EL EXCORSITO"

Cheeze learns about a possessed teenage girl at the San Gabriel Arcángel Apartments. The gang decides she will be the center of their first episode of *805 Paranormal*.

EPISODE 3: "NINJA CUPCAKES"

The band gets hired to perform at a high school party, a typical venue for a garage band. While they're on stage, things get weird when a group of evil spirit possessed football players start a huge brawl against a gang of punk rockers.

EPISODE 4: "THE HAUNTED TACO TRUCK"

Juan, an 805 legend with the best tacos in town, passes away and leaves his son the taco truck to run. However, when Juan Jr. switches up the recipe it brings Juan Sr. back from the grave. Now he won't leave the taco truck no matter what.

EPISODE 5: "LA LLORONA"

The 805 Paranormal guys investigate reports of a scary ghost haunting the halls of the San Gabriel Arcángel Apartments. They soon learn the ghost is actually the legendary La Llorona. Now Davy must face the ghost he saw in childhood nightmares.

EPISODE CONCEPTS

EPISODE 6: "THE UNFORGIVEN"

Davy's neighbor, old man Jose, tortures his family while wrestling with demons from his past. This time the 805 Paranormal gang witness Father Elias during a confession that sends the demon back to Hell.

EPISODE 7: "NANNY CAM NIGHTMARE"

Cheeze hears about a family that captured a demon on a nanny cam hovering over a baby's cradle. When the 805 Paranormal guys investigate, they find an evil baby snatcher on the loose.

EPISODE 8: "YouTube Famous"

The 805 Paranormal guys cut a trailer for their ghost hunting show. It only gets a few views at first, but leads them to their next adventure, a real haunted house.

EPISODE 9: "THE MAGIC LANTERN"

Esmeralda taps the band ninja cupcakes to perform at her Magic Lantern Gentleman's club. In attendance are the town's most serious mafiosos. No need for demons to push these guys to the dark side.

EPISODE 10: "THE LAST DRAGON"

After unleashing hell in the 805, Davy and the gang must face their worst challenge yet, an enormous dragon from hell. The dragon appears at the beginning of the Apocalypse. Now the gang must unite with Zell to send the dragon back to hell and put off Armageddon.

FUTURE SEASONS

SEASON 1

A dark comedy about a band that starts a ghost hunting TV show, inadvertently starting Armageddon.

SEASON 2

805 Paranormal becomes a hit local show. Now people come to the gang with their ghost stories and horror shows. The band never really takes off, but the guys stay true to their roots and continue performing around town. More signs of Armageddon appear.

SEASON 3

The main focus of the season will be the Armageddon that Davy, Zell, and Esmeralda have all contributed to happening.



TONE

The series is a dark, comedic journey into the supernatural forces that influence the 805.

Set in a modern urban barrio the series offers a diversity of characters. Ghosts and demons occupy the neighborhood, but especially at the San Gabriel Arcángel Apartments. For some reason the luxury building behind it seems to be haunt free.


It will have visual styles of "Cowboy Bebop" and "Mob Psycho 100."
