- 30 min.
- Single camera
- Comedy, pseudo documentary/fake reality

Logline: The first reality show ever produced, when there were only two people on the entire planet. Year zero, if you will.

Tagline: No pressure. Just populate the earth.

We are talking about a contained cast:

- **Adam** The original alpha male. As dumb as they come, but give him a break. The poor guy has to learn everything the hard way, since there's no one to teach him. He pretty much assumes the world is made for him, and Eve is hers automatically.
- **Eve** The first and only woman. Considerably smarter than Adam. Many days younger than him, but she still seems to have a better grasp on things. Hers is the most important job in the universe, but it's not a given she'll do it.
