

SYNOPSIS


Bunker Spreckels is no ordinary troublemaker.



MAIN CHARACTER

VALERIE PETERS

MAIN CHARACTER

A fictionalized version of the love of Bunker's life, Ellie, VALERIE PETERS (20s) is a striking blonde with a Lakers' Girl figure who falls madly in love with Bunker's charms.

She can get any guy she wants but digs the lavish lifestyle and excitement that surrounds Bunker despite having to fend off countless girls willing to throw themselves at him. She wants to retire as a trophy wife and needs to feel like a princess.


Valerie enjoys simple pleasures like a lovely sunset but has expensive tastes such as a collection of designer shoes. Her worst fear is losing Bunker to another woman, or to other women in general.

ALFONSO GOMEZ

MAIN CHARACTER

ALFONSO GOMEZ (20s) is one of Bunker's few friends who ultimately becomes a Judas. He longs to be a big-time movie director and is building his reel with the California skate and surf scene. He's a decent surfer in his own right, who wants to make a name for himself with his innovative camera work.

His big break comes when Bunker hires him to document his life. Broke, out of work, and with the promise of adventure, Gomez agrees even though Bunker is only paying for his room and board. He is a cross between Andy Warhol and Kenneth Anger.

TUA

MAIN CHARACTER

TUA (60s), the old kahuna, is the spiritual leader of the native populace of the island who reveres Bunker and his family because they had supported King David Kalakaua, the last absolute Hawaiian monarch, in his battles against the interlopers.

Tua teaches Bunker things few would ever learn like the island lore and rites of passage. He even proclaims Bunker to be a reincarnated Hawaiian prince. He's a skilled craftsman who wants to carry on the shamanic traditions of the islands and share his knowledge as a surfboard maker.

PLOT

This heart-pounding epic follows the breathtaking journey of Bunker Spreckels, a penniless surfer who transforms from a wave-riding novice to an eccentric millionaire. When he inherits his family's sugar fortune following his absent father's demise, Bunker's life takes an unexpected turn.




