LOGLINE OF PILOT: A disastrous supervillain advertises for a sidekick in order to reassert his dominion over a quaint, little town.

SHORT SYNOPSIS OF PILOT: Draven, the self-proclaimed Bringer of Darkness has reigned “terror” in the middle of British suburbia peacefully...until now. Wolf Woman seeks to usurp him and possessing a sidekick will be the advantage he needs to chase her away for good.

GENRE: Mockumentary style comedy, drawing inspiration from This Country and What We Do In the Shadows.

TOP LINE OF SERIES: In a world where supervillains are as average and every day as your local postie, join a host of colourfully criminal characters as they navigate the BSS (British Supervillain Society). Experience the highs and lows of a village villain fighting to keep his position from an emerging rival, or voyage on a journey of supervillain discovery with the new kid on the block starting their BSS application process.

WHY DASTARDLY DEEDS? Hollywood only ever highlight the BEST of British Villainy but not everyone can be up to par with those screen stealers. British comedy lends itself to mockumentary so well and its time we let out absurdity and awkwardness shine!

INTRODUCING....

DRAVEN – Aka The Bringer of Darkness

No one in the small town of Crowbridge seems to care that they have a middle-aged towering, leather and feather clad villain waltzing around looking like the reject of a heavy metal band. His

idea of Super Villainy is perhaps not what the average citizen would consider evil and certainly not up to standard with his fellow colleagues.

Dramatic, absurd and petty would be a few ways in which to describe him but a threat to Crowbridge society? No. No one would describe him as that. Which is why when Draven is faced with a rival in Wolf Woman trying to claim Crowbridge as hers, he rallies to prove his villainous worth to the entire town.

MAISIE – Aka The Goody Two Shoes

Working hard and miserably in her nine to five, Maisie has never stepped a foot wrong in her life. She tuts at queue breakers, tuts at bad grammar online, tuts at everyone who walks over her and has never felt the need to change that. However, an excruciatingly bad day pushes Maisie to her limits and when she wrongly receives a BSS application form, she simply asks herself, why not? Extra cash, a bit of fun, what's not to love?

DENNIS – Aka The Grandson and Heir

Whether Dennis likes it or not (spoiler he doesn't) he is descended from British Supervillain royalty and his grandmother who presides over the London criminal network refuses to retire unless her favourite grandson is the one who takes the highly sought after criminal throne. Dennis has hopes, dreams and aspirations but none align with his grandmother's. His family plead with Dennis to humour her, all of them vying to be the chosen one, and so Dennis agrees apprentice under her.

Dastardly Deeds – Series One:

Series one of Dastardly Deeds will seek to introduce this alternative Britain and follow three stories residing in it through the style of Mockumentary.

Draven will lose his fight against Wolf Woman and witness the place he calls home idolize her and the tourism she brings to Crowbridge. However, she soon takes it a step too far and the town cries out for Draven's return. It is up to Draven to pull his act together and win the war.

Maisie will journey through the Supervillain application process, create her persona, create her costume, create her lair and all whilst continuing to balance her everyday life. However, she gives little thought to the world she's signed up for and is left floundering when she's targeted by a legendary British superhero.

Dennis finally agrees to humour his grandmother's pleas but vows to be the worst Supervillain ever to exist with the intention of opening his grandmother's eyes to see that he is not fit to be the heir. He is dragged along on several operations actively trying to be the very worst possible...except...he soon discovers that he's kinda good at it. The plan isn't aided by the fact that he develops a crush on a poorly performing Superhero and becomes his nemesis in order to send him soaring in the public eye.

Dastardly Deeds – The Future:

There are so many opportunities for Dastardly Deeds heading into further series. However, I do foresee a Super Villain awards (akin to the Oscars) becoming a fantastic arching plotline for a future series.
