Undeterred, Nick discovers that his friend Alex's cousin secured an artist visa as a singer in a band. Inspired, Nick hatches a plan to create a fake band, "Pure Vortex," with his friends to obtain artist visas and work for his uncle. Initially hesitant, his friends eventually embrace the idea, recruiting a talented drummer and leveraging the drummer's sister, a reporter, to craft a convincing backstory and generate media coverage.

Balancing their day jobs as equipment movers with their new persona, the friends navigate the challenges of maintaining the facade, culminating in a successful visa application. 



# ORIGIN OF THE STORY:





























#### TARGET AUDIENCE

The target audience for the comedy film Pure Vortex is based on the demographics of moviegoers in the following areas:

United States: With 18% of moviegoers aged 18-24 and 27% aged 25-39, should appeal to young adults in their late teens and early to mid-30s in the United States. Additionally, with an even split between male and female moviegoers, the film should appeal to a broad audience in terms of gender.
